What is Sustainable Development under the UN Agenda 21 Plan?

The objective of sustainable development is to integrate economic, social and environmental policies in order to achieve reduced consumption, social equity (redistribution of all wealth), and the preservation and restoration of biodiversity. Proponents insist that every societal decision focuses on three components; global land use, global education, and global population control and reduction. They claim that national sovereignty is a social injustice and that universal health care is necessary for social justice to exist. The origin of the term sustainable development was a 1987 UN report by the VP of the World Socialist Party and it was first issued as official UN Policy in 1992 in a document called *UN Sustainable Development Agenda 21*.

“Land...cannot be treated as an ordinary asset, controlled by individuals and subject to the pressures and inefficiencies of the market. Private land ownership is also a principle instrument of accumulation and concentration of wealth, therefore contributes to social injustice.” -*From the report from the 1976 UN's Habitat I Conference.*

“Current lifestyles and consumption patterns of the affluent middle class – involving high meat intake, use of fossil fuels, appliances, home and work air conditioning, and suburban housing are not sustainable.” -Maurice Strong, Secretary General of the UN's Earth Summit, 1992.

“Individual rights will have to take a back seat to the collective.” -*Harvey Ruvin, Vice Chairman, ICLEI. The Wildlands Project.*

“We must make this place an insecure and inhospitable place for Capitalists and their projects – we must reclaim the roads and plowed lands, halt dam construction, tear down existing dams, free shackled rivers and return to wilderness tens of millions of acres of presently settled land.” -*Dave Foreman, Earth First.*

“Participating in a UN advocated planning process would very likely bring out many of the conspiracy- fixated groups and individuals in our society... This segment of our society who fear ‘one-world government’ and a UN invasion of the United States through which our individual freedom would be stripped away would actively work to defeat any elected official who joined ‘the conspiracy’ by undertaking LA21. So we call our process something else, such as comprehensive planning, growth management or smart growth.” -*J. Gary Lawrence, advisor to President Clinton's Council on Sustainable Development.*

Who is behind it?

ICLEI – Local Governments for Sustainability (formally, International Council for Local Environmental Initiatives). Communities pay ICLEI dues to provide “local” community plans to implement Agenda 21. **Local Agenda 21 projects include:** Smart Growth, Wildlands Project, Regional Visioning Projects, STAR Sustainable Communities, Green jobs, Green Building Codes, “Going Green,” Alternative Energy, Local Visioning, facilitators, regional planning, conservation easements, development rights, sustainable farming, and comprehensive planning.
